## A Message From Our Pastor

**Dear Parishioners,**

After a week of Trick-or-Treating, candy, and time spent with family, I wanted to take a moment to remind everyone. Children belong at Mass. Can it be difficult at times to bring kids to Mass? Yes, but I am always happy to see and hear young families at Mass. Whether there's perfect attention, fussing, or crying, I'm just happy kids are with us.

This past week I asked a few parents for some tips or tricks they use to bring their family to Mass. Here's what they came up with.

**Find a time that works for your family**

"I used to think that I had to take my three young kids to the Family Mass, but sometimes I found that it wasn't ideal due to nap times, sports, or my husband's work schedule. Some Sundays the early Mass is easiest because the baby sleeps through it and the other two enjoy getting bagels afterwards. Some Sundays we're at the evening Mass, and others we are at the Family Mass. Being open to other Mass times has certainly lessened stress."

**Sit where you're comfortable**

"When I first started coming to Mass with my kids, I felt like I needed to sit in the back so I could run out as soon as one started fussing. One Sunday, a friend suggested I sit up close in the front. What a difference. The kids can see so they're more engaged, there's always room in the front, and when the baby does cry there are side doors so I can still step out."

**Mass begins at Home**

"Going to Mass used to be an anxiety-inducing nightmare; trying to get my kids dressed, fed, and out the door, fighting in the car because they didn't finish their show or game on their device, and then rushing into Mass late trying to find a seat.

Last Lent we decided to start Mass prep earlier in addition to being okay with going to the next Mass if needed. Giving our family more time, by setting

outfits and Mass bags out the night before, and having extra time made me less stressed and less likely to yell, which also made my kids less stressed. We still have those days, but now Sunday mornings are much more peaceful."

**Kids can understand Mass**

"I used to think Mass would be uninteresting to my kids, but they can surprise you. I gave my kids children's books about Mass so they could follow along and use the activity sheets the church offers. Before Mass, I ask my kids who or what they want to pray for at Mass and we talk about what we saw, learned, and experienced at Mass on the way home."

**Find time without screens outside of Mass**

"I probably gave too much screen time with my first kid, and Mass was hard, but honestly it was the only time he didn't have a screen to pacify him. Now we try to limit screen time for various mental health reasons. Because we do this, Mass isn't this abruption of screenless time."

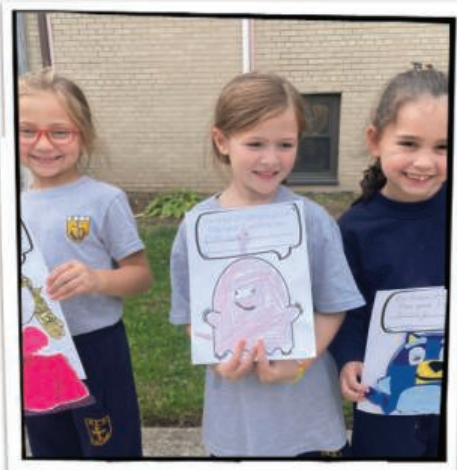
**Grandparents are rockstars**

"After a particularly difficult Sunday when my wife couldn't get off shift at the hospital, I prepared to leave our cheerio-covered pew embarrassed that the older woman who sat behind us would be upset, especially with one kid making noise and the other making faces at her during the homily. Rather than yelling this awesome grandma said to me, 'Honey, I raised six kids and have ten grandkids, you're doing a great job.'"

As they say, if the Church isn't crying, it's dying. Thank you to all our parents who bring their kids to Mass and who are trying to raise a family of faith in this ever-changing world.

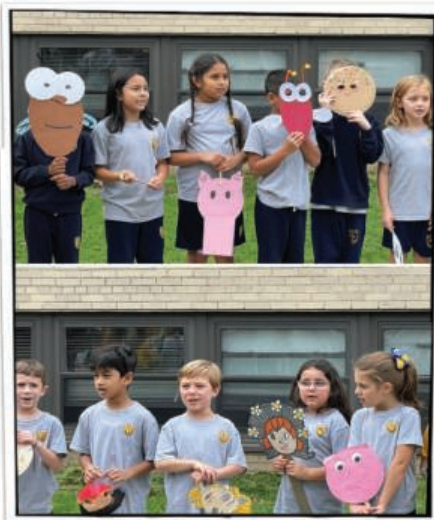

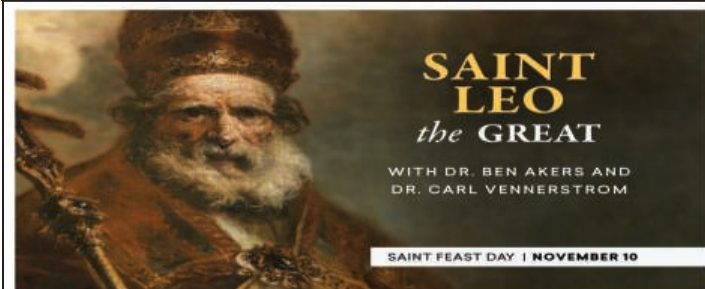

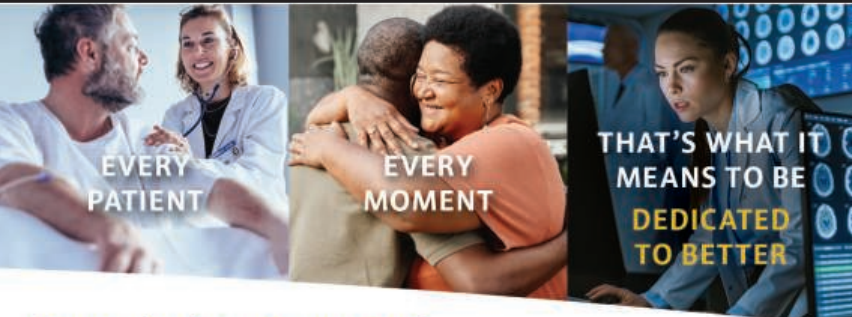
