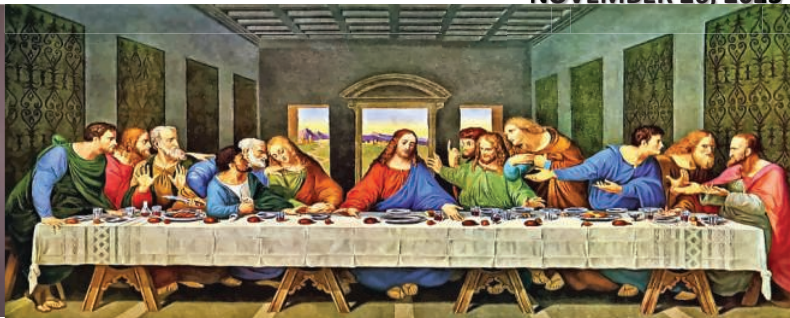

## A Message From Our Pastor

**Dear Parishioners,**

This Thursday, November 30th, our parish will receive a visit from a Vatican representative bringing the Relic of St. Jude the Apostle, Patron Saint of Impossible Causes.

The relic will be in the church for public veneration from **1:00 pm - 10:00 pm**. **There will be Mass at 7:00 pm**, during which veneration will pause.

**Who to Invite**

Invite everyone, especially those in need of a miracle or those who have fallen away from the faith. Perhaps your neighbor will not go to Mass on Sundays, but they might come out to venerate an apostle and the patron saint of the impossible.

**What about the Infirm?**

If you have trouble walking, or a loved one is particularly ill and feeble, there will be an express line - as we do not want to deter those who might need prayers the most from coming.

**What to Expect**

Possibly a long line. Use that time to pray. In fact, don't wait until you get to the relic to start your prayers, as due to the long lines, visitors cannot stay very long immediately before the relic - though you can always sit in the pews to pray.

**What to Bring**

Feel free to bring any religious items you would want to touch to the exhibit, which makes them 3rd class relics. Bring your prayer intentions.

**Prayers to St. Jude**

You have likely seen the shrine to St. Jude in the lobby of the church. Feel free to write a prayer, light a candle, and ask St. Jude to intercede to Jesus for you or your loved one.

**Gain a Plenary Indulgence**

Everyone who comes to venerate the relic will receive a plenary indulgence as long as they:

1. **Pray for the Pope**
2. Receive the Sacrament of **Confession** within twenty days of visiting the relics.
3. Receive **Holy Communion** within the same twenty days while free from grave sin.
4. Resolve to **end all relationships with sin**, even venial (i.e., non-mortal) sin. This condition is by far the most difficult and requires explaining. It entails making the decision that you will never sin again. This does not mean you lose the indulgence if you sin again. Once gained, an indulgence cannot be lost. However, it requires the decision in the heart to remove any ongoing relationship or dependency with sin.

**For Those for Whom Visiting the Relic is Not Possible Due to Serious Inconvenience**

Persons of old age, the sick, and all who are unable to leave their home for a serious reason (e.g., travel distance) may likewise gain the plenary indulgence after fulfilling condition #1 above and conditions #2-4 "as soon as possible" and fulfilling the additional condition of "joining themselves spiritually to St. Jude's holy pilgrimage and offering their prayers, sufferings, and inconveniences to our merciful God.

**May One Obtain a Plenary Indulgence on Behalf of Someone Else?**

A plenary indulgence may be obtained for oneself, offered for the soul of someone already deceased (or for the dead in general), but it cannot be applied to another still living.

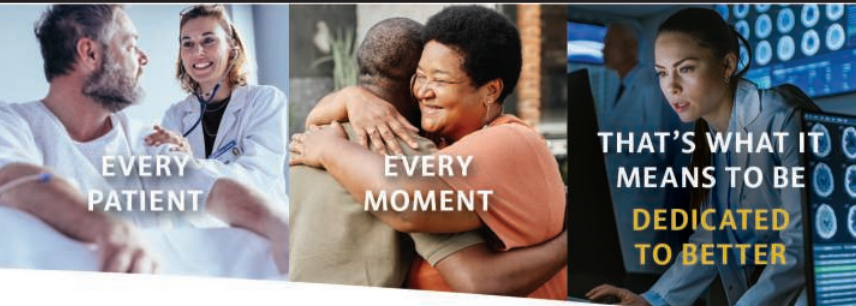
