A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As hard as it might be to believe for some, Thanksgiving is already here. For many this is a day for eating too much food, watching football, and enjoying time with friends and family.

It can also be an occasion for arguments, especially once the kids go downstairs and the adults are left to talk. Maybe because you go to church, your family will turn to you to complain about religion and the Church. So here are some tips and quick points you can bring to the table.

Avoid dishonest arguments.

Is your uncle or cousin *actually* curious about a point of theology or are they just *stirring the pot*? Sometimes the best strategy is to make a joke and move on. Especially if adult beverages are involved.

Ask the person to expand on their point.

Rather than jumping to respond to a point, perhaps ask “Hmm, what do you mean by that?” or “Can you expand on that, why do you think that is the case?” or “What do you think the Church actually teaches?”, etc. By asking a follow up, we can flesh out a belief rather than just arguing about catchphrases or slogans.

Offer the truth with charity,

We can give the perfect doctrinal explanation, but if we come off like a jerk, we lose the argument. I know it can be tempting to give a sharp answer, especially with certain relatives, but try to resist.

It's ok to say I don't know.

If you don't know why the Church teaches something, it's ok to admit it. It doesn't mean the other person is right, it just means we don't have the answer to the question they're asking. A good place to look it up is (*Catholic Answers*.) In fact, saying you'll look it up is a good invitation to continue a conversation later and share a video or article with a relative.

Make sure to Pray for them

After having a conversation or argument with a relative, make sure to pray for them at Mass. The best weapon we have is the power of the Holy Spirit; let God soften and convict their hearts. In fact, if you know beforehand that you will most likely have a bad conversation with a relative, say a prayer before you head over. We can pray to God asking for the gift of prudence, patience, wisdom, courage, docility, etc.

Bring college kids to confession

Allow this to be my regular reminder to bring college students, home for the weekend, to the Sacrament of Confession (and go yourself). A young person will never ask a parent to drive them to confession and admit the shenanigans they've done so far this semester in college; bring them anyway.

Depending on how your Thanksgiving dinner conversation goes, maybe bring the whole family too.

5th Grade Science & Tech

5th Grade participated in a science lab on solubility. After learning scientific vocabulary words including solution, solvent and solute, students tested whether 5 household items were soluble in water or not. They found that the sugar and food coloring were soluble, but the pepper, vegetable oil and sprinkles were not. The science labs help students develop critical thinking and problem solving along with gaining exposure to reactions and materials in a lab setting.

Our 5th graders also buddled up with the 2nd grade to help them create a Google Slide Presentation during Technology Class. As part of the 2nd grade's Social Studies unit, they had to interview a family member and record their results. The two grades worked very well together and our 2nd graders are excited to present their slides!

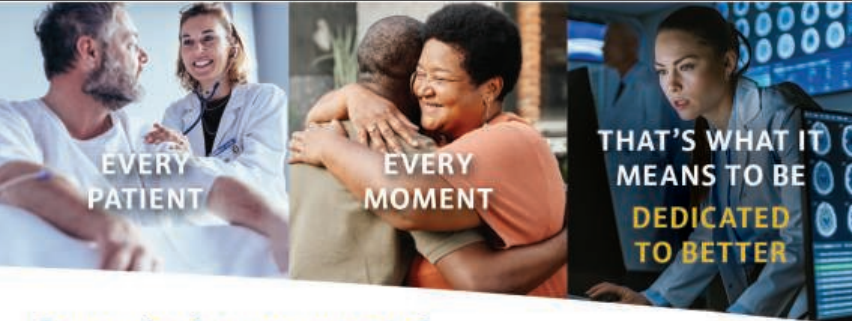
