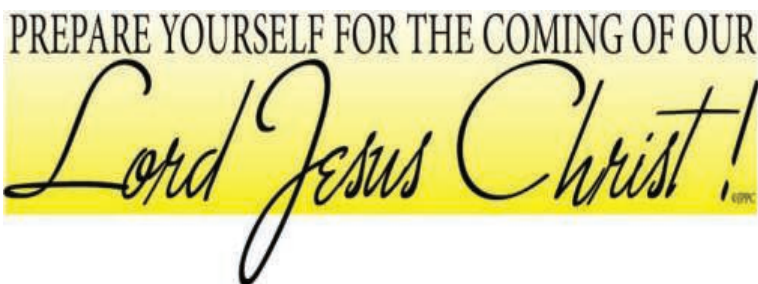

A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I know I often bring up the same points at Mass and in these letters.

Certainly, if one wanted to draft a fake Fr. Sullivan homily, throwing in a line about the Sacrament of Confession, a plea to be faithful to Sunday Mass, or a challenge to bring friends to Jesus would be a good start.

Why is it that we have to strive to increase our intellectual understanding of the faith? Why do we need to strive for lives of virtue and holiness? Why is it what we should be sharing about our faith and actively inviting people to encounter Jesus Christ?

Because the opposite doesn't work.

One hundred years ago it would have been safe to assume that every American knew the basics of Christianity. It would be unthinkable that one would not know the story of Noah and the Ark, Adam and Eve, or the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ. While people certainly didn't always follow them, it could be expected that the average person had a working knowledge of the commandments and basic morality.

Not anymore. Like I've mentioned, more often than not, when I walk around or go into stores people do not know that I'm a priest or how to address me. So many people could not tell you the story of Moses and Pharaoh if offered \$1,000. Likewise, the idea of something being *actually wrong* or virtuous is now seen as hateful and closed-minded.

Parents and individuals will move mountains to find time and resources for their activity of choice, but worshiping and following Christ has gone by the wayside.

While it's tempting to get frustrated and blame a generation of people, we have to remember that most generations absorbed 90% of what they know from the culture. The same is true today, except that today's culture is secular.

We need to know our faith because we can't trust society to pass it down. Moreover, we need good answers to combat the many lies our secular culture offers people today.

Why do we need to invite people instead of merely allowing them to see our witness and joy; inspiring them to seek out Jesus too? Often, we hear that quote, falsely attributed to St. Francis "*Preach the Gospel always, used words if necessary.*" Why isn't our Christian witness good enough? Because it wasn't even for Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ the Word made flesh and Splendor of the Father had to invite people- and often get rejected.

Why do we need to strive after virtue and frequent the sacrament of confession? First, we need to strive for our own salvation. But when it comes to evangelization, we need to remember it's not a head-to-head fight. The person away from God is also being tempted not to go back. The evil one might say "*Why follow Jesus, they do and they still sin, they're hypocrites.*"

We strive to become holy so that when one encounters our Christian community they might say, "*wow, what a kind, joyful, and peaceful group.*" We go to confession so that when they see our sins, we can say, "*Yes, I am a sinner, but I know the mercy of Christ.*" We cultivate a life of prayer so that the Holy Spirit might draw those fallen away back to His Sacred Heart and combat those temptations of doubt with reassurances whispered by guardian angels.

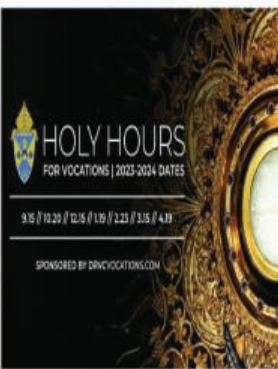
