A Message From Our Pastor

*Dear Parishioners,*Happy Feast of the Holy Family

On this Feast of the Holy Family, I just want to say, thank you. Holy Family Parish is the amazing parish it is because of our many holy families. And to all of our new families, who have joined us this past year; welcome.

Feast of the Epiphany

Next Sunday is the Feast of the Epiphany, also known as Little Christmas or the Feast of the Three Kings.

On this feast, there are three blessings I would like to bring to your attention; some old, some new.

Blessing of Incense

After Christ was born, wise men brought gifts of frankincense, gold, and myrrh. To commemorate this event the Church has a tradition where the incense we will use at Holy Mass is presented and blessed.

Just as the gifts of the Magi were a reminder of God's presence, even though hidden in the form of a child, incense at Mass is a sensible reminder of our prayers going up to God and His True Presence, even though hidden in the form of bread and wine.

Blessing of Holy Water

While we commonly associate the Epiphany with the visit of the Magi, the early Church associated the feast with Our Lord's Baptism, which is now a separate feast. Thus, there arose a tradition of the Solemn Blessing of Holy Water. This water is primarily to be used in the blessing of homes and schools.

Some have commonly referred to Epiphany Water as Super Holy Water because of the elaborate blessing it receives and its effectiveness in the homes where it is sprinkled.

The Solemn Blessing of Epiphany Water will be at 1:00 pm in the Church. Parishioners are invited to bring their own water in containers to be blessed. This special blessing will be done according to the ancient rite of the Church and can only be done once a year.

Blessing of Chalk and of Homes

In years past I know this parish has distributed Epiphany Blessing Cards to be hung above the doors of our homes. However, the more common tradition is the Solemn Blessing of Epiphany Chalk.

The Church first began using chalk as a reminder of God's plan for the sanctification of the world. Just as chalk can be wiped away at the end of each lesson, so too can our sins, especially in the new year. Each year is a chance to begin again with Christ.

At each Mass, we will bless the Epiphany Chalk and invite every family to take a piece home with them. Then each family can choose which door or doors the blessing 20 + C+M+B +24 is written. CMB can refer to either the names of the wise men or the translation of the Latin phrase *May Christ Bless This Home*. As the inscription is written a parent will read the blessing provided by the parish, thus blessing their home for the new year.

Priestly Blessing of Homes

While priests are available any time of year to bless homes, if you would like your home blessed for the new year, please just let us know; send us an email (email addresses are located in the back of the bulletin).

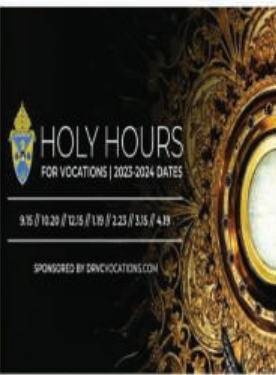
