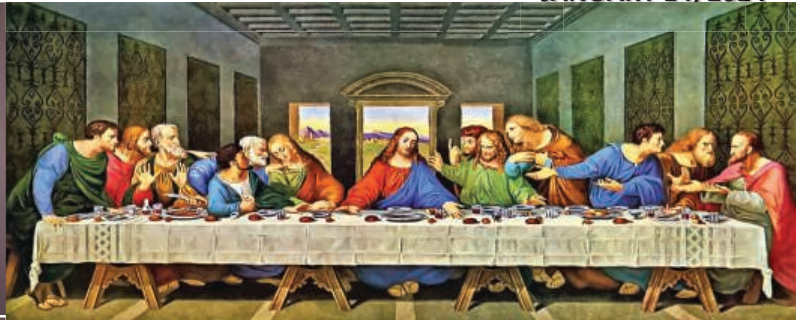

A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday Holy Family is happy to host the Sisters of Life at our Masses.

The Sisters of Life are a contemplative/active Roman Catholic community of women religious, who profess the three traditional vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, and a fourth vow to protect and enhance the sacredness of human life. They were founded by Cardinal John O'Connor in New York in 1991, and received formal approbation as a religious institute in 2004.

They currently serve in the [Arch]dioceses of New York, Albany, Bridgeport, Philadelphia, Denver, Phoenix, Washington, D.C., and Toronto, Canada. Their missions include serving women who are vulnerable to abortion, giving them the support and resources to be able to choose life for themselves and their children; hosting weekend retreats; evangelization; outreach to college students; and helping women who have suffered after abortion to encounter the mercy and healing of Jesus Christ.

In a country so wounded by abortion, especially in the State of New York, the Sisters of Life offer something we priests cannot fully offer in the confessional. Yes, we can forgive any sins in the confessional, but through their retreats, the Sisters of Life offer *healing and hope*. Hope for the Young Church

On December 16-17, Father Gabriel Gillen, O.P. came to Holy Family to speak about FOCUS, the Fellowship of Catholic University

Students. Over the break, I was able to go with him to their SEEK Conference in St. Louis where I served as the Master of Ceremonies for all their liturgies.

This year over 24,000 college students and young adults came from across the country, and even across the globe to pray together and seek the Lord.

One might ask, what were these young people looking for? What drew them to come?

Overwhelmingly they wanted reverent Masses, where the focus was on Jesus Christ. They wanted sacred silence and time in Adoration - everyday the Perpetual Adoration Chapel was filled with 2,000 students silently praying. They wanted the sacrament of confession, with lines of thousands waiting patiently to encounter God's Mercy. They wanted to learn about the faith in its fullness and depth, they wanted to be challenged, and to be told the truth. This conference featured speakers like Fr. Mike Schmitz, Matt Fradd, Jeff Cavins, Scott Hahn, and more.

I know it can be disheartening sometimes to see so many young people fall away, and the temptation can be to try to minimize what we believe. The joy found with these young people reminds me that there is hope and that only Jesus Christ and the fullness of His Truth will ever draw people closer.
