A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Why do we need Catholic Schools?

Because we need God.

We live in a fallen, imperfect, and messed-up world. Has it always been broken? For certain. Does the brokenness feel different now? It does. We can read or remember generations who peacefully protested for basic civil rights, about young men who traded in baseball cleats for Army boots and went off to war, and how pastors and parishioners were given the task of literally building a parish from the ground up.

Any of those realities, and so many others faced in the past would be enough to double one's blood pressure, and yet the struggle so many face is the struggle of just getting through the day.

It's not just that we are more aware of anxiety and worry; people actually are more anxious, even if it's kept under control.

Is it smartphones? Maybe; probably, but that's not it. What did my grandfather's generation have that so many children today do not? God.

We as a Western culture have expelled God from the narrative. Sometimes God makes an appearance at Christmas or on Ash Wednesday, but the idea of children growing up to believe that God made them, that right and wrong exist independent of us, that sin and hell are real, and the belief that Heaven and grace exist is gone.

Secular society teaches children they can create their own purpose and reality, forgetting that doing so is only possible if they do not already have purpose from the moment of conception and do not already belong to a reality greater than themselves.

For years, many chose Catholic Schools like Holy Family because they offer quality education. Others wanted good values instilled in their children; certainly, this is still the case with our non-Christian parents.

However, we need Catholic Schools like Holy Family more than ever today because they introduce children to the person of Jesus Christ. In a world of meaninglessness where people spend years trying to find purpose, our students are given the ultimate purpose before they can tie their shoes; that they are made in the image and likeness of God, endowed with dignity and grace, called to know, love, and serve the Lord in this life, and to be with Him forever in Heaven.

I am so proud of our school and am so thankful that we have one with both healthy enrollment and the ability to expand what we offer each year. Every classroom has a holy water font where children bless themselves as they enter, remembering that there is no part of their lives; not math, science, music, or art, where God's meaning and love do not permeate.

Every morning our daily Mass welcomes children who kneel in silent adoration before Mass and receive the Eucharist before beginning the day. Each month our students from the youngest toddler to the oldest teen sit in silent Eucharistic Adoration during All Day First Friday Adoration, while confession is offered for those who desire to encounter the merciful heart of God, the cure all our heart's aches and worries.

We need Catholic Schools like Holy Family more than ever today because we need God more than ever, and if a child comes to Holy Family, he or she will meet God.

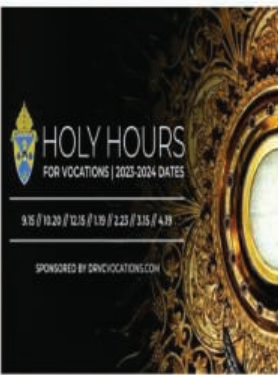

Holy Family CYO Tommy O Memorial Scholarship



Holy Family CYO has created a scholarship to honor the memory of Tommy Orlando. Tommy, who died tragically in 12/08, was a long time coach at Holy Family CYO and also coached youth sports for several other organizations in Hicksville. Holy Family CYO awards two \$1000 scholarships annually to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college or university
- Applicant must have a high school GPA of 80 or higher
- Applicant must have substantial community service experience during their high school career-as determined by the CYO selection committee
- Applicant must have been a member of Holy Family CYO for a minimum of 2 years

Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or guidance officer and proof of their high school GPA. Applicants also must submit an activity sheet which details their community service experiences during high school. A cover letter should accompany the required documentation and should describe the applicant's participation in Holy Family CYO, including years of participation and sports played.

At the time the scholarship selections are made students may be requested to show proof of enrollment in an accredited college or university.

All documentation should be mailed to: Ed Hebron 2 Mitchell Ct Hicksville NY 11801. Documentation must be received by March 10, 2024. Hicksville High School students should submit their application to the Hicksville High School guidance office by the deadline shown in the HHS Directory of Local Scholarships booklet.

Scholarship winners will be selected by the Holy Family CYO selection committee.
