A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

With Lent beginning this week, I wanted to offer everyone a Confession Cheat Sheet.

Of course, if you don't know what to do you can just tell the priest and he will happily help you, and the Act of Contrition is written down in the confessional.

Step 1: Make the choice to go

Unfortunately, many Catholics have stopped the practice of going to confession. We live in an increasingly desacramentalized world. People seek God without the Eucharist, meaning without baptism, and forgiveness without absolution. As Catholics, we are impelled to confession and seek absolution at least once a year and as soon as we can after committing a mortal sin. If we find ourselves in serious sin, we refrain from receiving Holy Communion until we are in the state of grace.

We choose to go to Confession because God is merciful and longs to forgive us.

Step 2: Make a good examination of conscience

Take time to examine your life. Are there mortal sins, habitual venial sins; what have you done and what have you failed to do? Do not be afraid or embarrassed, there is nothing beyond God's mercy.

Step 3: Schedule a meeting if you need

Confession is for confessing our sins, not our neighbor's sins, our children's sins, or to get advice on our life, or complain about our troubles. If you need counsel, make an appointment with a priest and we'll be happy to speak with you in our office.

Steps in the Confessional

1) **"Bless me Father, for I have sinned, it has been x amount of time since my last confession"** If you can't remember, try something general or say you can't remember.

2) Confess your sins in number and kind.

An approximate number is important as it can change the gravity of a sin: "I stole \$1" vs "I stole \$1 daily for 50 years". It can also help to see if a sin is a moment of weakness or a pattern of sin.

3) No need for stories or justification.

Don't think you have to hide your sins or try to give excuses for them. You will be forgiven no matter what. My advice is if there is a difficult sin to confess, confess it first. Simply say what it is, no need to sugar-coat it, use a different phrase, or give the background. Give the sin to God and be done with it.

4) Make an Act of Contrition

Note: There's no right or wrong Act of Contrition. Depending on when and where you went to 2nd grade, you might know a different version. All you need to do is express contrition for your sins.

Act of Contrition

**O my God,
I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee,
and I detest all my sins,
because I dread the loss of heaven,
and the pains of hell;
but most of all because they offend Thee, my God,
Who are all good and deserving of all my love.
I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace,
to confess my sins, to do penance,
and to amend my life.**

Amen.

5) Receive absolution and say your penance

As a reminder, when you leave, you are forgiven. The penance doesn't earn God's mercy - that's what the cross and our Lord's Sacred Heart are for. Instead, penance is a first step in healing our hearts and the wounds caused by sin.

6) Go and sin no more..... or come back when you sin again.

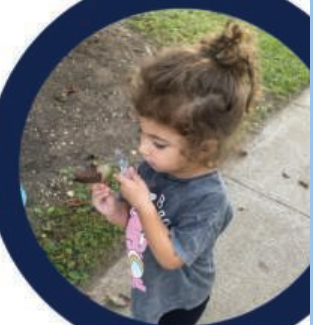

Lenten Observations

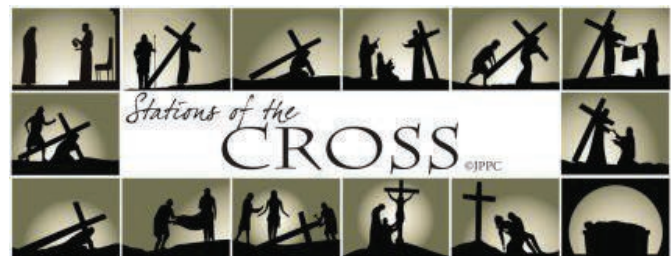
In Catholic liturgical and spiritual tradition, Lent is a "preparation for the celebration of Easter. For the Lenten liturgy disposes both catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery." (Roman Calendar, 27) This is accomplished through the liturgy itself, and by penitential practices such as fasting, almsgiving and intensive prayer. These are designed to foster conversion, reconciliation, purification, and healing with God, oneself and the community, especially for those preparing to celebrate the Easter Sacraments.

Abstinence from Meat

All Catholics who have reached their fourteenth year are bound to abstain entirely from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting

All Catholics between the ages of eighteen and fifty-nine inclusive are also bound to observe the law of fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.

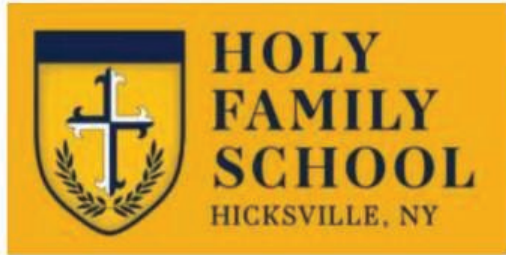

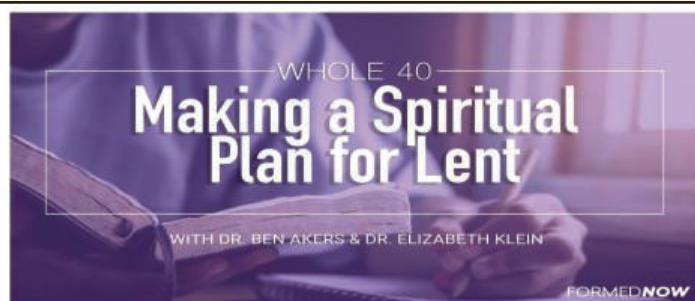
