***Dear Parishioners,***

I'm not often envious of Protestant churches, but one thing I am envious of is their long sermons. Unless I were to go to Africa, where homilies are expected to be long, I know it's expected that I keep my homilies brief and to the point.

However, we know there is far more to learn about our faith than can be fit into a fifteen minute homily. This Lent Holy Family will offer a series of lectures and I would invite everyone to attend and deepen their knowledge and faith.

I also know no time is perfect with everyone's busy schedules. This year we will offer our Lenten Lectures Saturdays at 6:00 pm in the Parish Center. One could attend the 5:00 pm Mass, attend the lecture, and be out for dinner by 7:00 pm.

Every Monday Holy Family has Eucharistic Adoration and Confession from 7:00 pm - 8:00 pm. I invite everyone to try to come out at least once this Lent. Sacrifice your evening TV program, and visit our Lord for a few minutes - you don't have to stay the full hour.

**Stations of the Cross**

Beginning this week, Holy Family will once again have Stations of the Cross every Wednesday at 3:00 pm and every Friday at 7:00 pm in the church. The text for the stations can be found in the back of the hymnals.

I would encourage everyone to try to make at least one of these afternoons and evenings and to bring your families. As a child, I remember going to the Stations every Friday in Lent before going to the pizzeria. While it was only fifteen minutes, it allowed me to cement the story of our Lord's passion into my mind and heart.

For those who cannot attend, there is also the pious tradition of walking the Stations yourself whenever you have a chance.

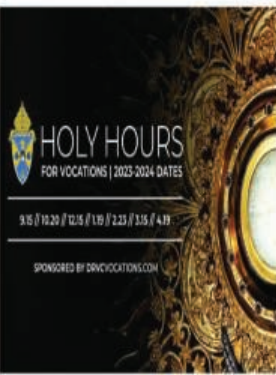

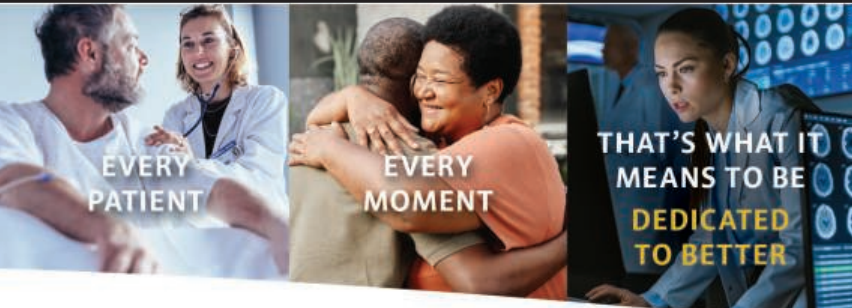
