## A Message From Our Pastor

*Dear Parishioners,*

This weekend we hear in the Gospel of St. Mark the account of Jesus driving the money-changers and vendors out of the temple. Why then do we have a collection, bake sales, and other fundraisers at Mass and in the church lobby?

Before I was a priest, I assumed that my parish or the local cathedral hadn't read or understood the gospel account. Is Jesus saying the Church is forbidden from using money or receiving donations? Certainly not. The gospels tell us that Jesus had followers who supported Him out of the surplus of their wealth.

At the end of the day, our collections and fundraisers go to support the mission of the Church. Sadly, because of the economy and because the vast percentage of Catholics do not faithfully attend Mass, almost all of our funds go to keep the lights on, doors open, and our staff employed.

Why were they selling animals in the temple?

In the Jewish temple people worshipped by sacrificing animals. While many towns had synagogues to learn and pray, there was only one temple to offer worship to God. And the temple was in Jerusalem. If you lived far away it would be difficult or unfeasible to bring an animal with you, so there were animals one could purchase there.

Why are there money changers?

The temple would not allow one to use a coin where the emperor is depicted as a god; the sin of idolatry. So one would exchange their foreign coin for a shekel to use in the temple complex.

What's the problem?

There are several problems, but one major one is that main vendors and money-changers took advantage of travelers by gouging prices and offering unfair exchange rates in order to personally profit. Some priests could also declare an animal unclean, meaning the person had to purchase another animal.

The money changers and vendors ought to have been there to support the temple and facilitate people's worship; instead they were there to make money for corrupt purposes and personal gains.

Moreover, Jesus drives them out because He is the new temple and the new sacrifice. One does not have to buy a lamb because Jesus is the new Lamb of God. One does not have to journey to Jerusalem to worship, but can now worship anywhere from Haifa to Hicksville.

What can we learn from the temple?

One thing we can learn is the need to worship. How many today would go on a week's journey by foot and pay a fortune to worship God like the Jewish people of Jesus did? Sometimes we don't worship at Mass because we're sleepy or because we have sports. Whatever is holding us back, let's pray Jesus would drive that out of our hearts.

### Blood Drive Update

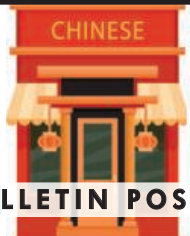
