A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Laetare Sunday.

Laetare Sunday gets its name from the Latin Entrance Antiphon, Laetare Jerusalem, Rejoice Jerusalem. If you can't remember which Sunday is Laetare Sunday and which is Gaudete, just remember the double L's: Laetare Lent.

Laetare Sunday traditionally marks a few things:

1) The Half-way point of Lent

If you've ever run a 5K you'll know the importance of mile markers and the stopwatch. Going into the race a runner might have a goal in mind and, as they reach each marker they can ask "How is my pace? Am I too fast, too slow, or right on the money?"

How is our Lenten pace? Hopefully, we all set goals on Ash Wednesday. How are we doing? Are we praying every day or have we not picked up our rosaries or bibles in two weeks? In a race, we know we can either pick up the pace if we can or if we're so far behind we make a new goal. If we've been missing the mark so far, let's either pick up the pace or make a new goal.

2) Refreshment Sunday

While we're not in the gold and white vestment yet, this weekend gives us a small peak at Easter. The rose chasuble and simple flowers remind us joy is coming soon, much like the first beams of dawn signal the rising sun.

If your focus has been on the negative - not eating XYZ or not doing something, take time and pray on the joy that will come with overcoming a habitual vice; even pray about the infinite bliss that is Heaven.

3) Golden Rose Sunday

It was on this Sunday that popes would bless and send Golden Roses to Catholic royalty and heads of state who had served the Church faithfully in the years past.

With the fall of many monarchies, the Church has for the last century bestowed a Golden Rose to a church of great importance. This year Pope Francis sent his Golden Rose to the Philippines to the International Shrine of Our Lady of Peace and Good Voyage in thanksgiving for its elevation as an international shrine. This is the first rose sent to the Marian Church in Asia.

While you don't need to offer a rose, maybe consider thanking one person in your life who has been there for you in the past year, someone who helped you get through a tough time. Maybe offer a Rosary for them.

3) Mothering Sunday

Laetare Sunday is also called Mothering Sunday, in reference to Paul's second letter to the Corinthians, where the faithful are called "sons and daughters of God". On this day Catholics have either visited their "Mother Church", either the church of their baptism, or the Cathedral, the mother church of the diocese.

Today, perhaps consider talking to your family about where you were baptized. Maybe say a prayer to the patron saint of the church.

Hang in there

Palm Sunday is two weeks away and Easter three. Hang tough and do your best to strive for holiness. Pray for those who are still away from Jesus and His Church. Offer prayers especially for those who will come to Mass to *get their palms* - through God's grace may they encounter Jesus and follow Him in a new way.

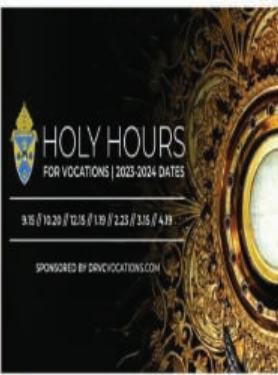

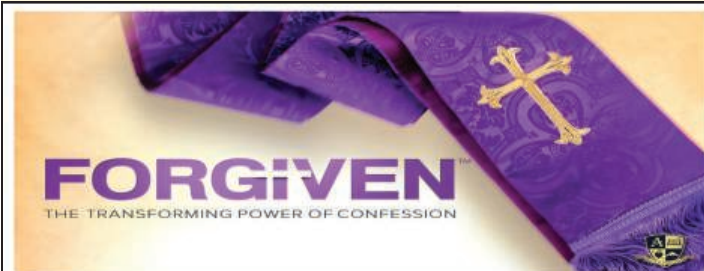
