A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter and Happy Divine Mercy Sunday. Last Sunday it was, as it always is encouraging to see so many people come to Easter Mass. Holy Family saw an almost 100% increase in Mass attendance compared to a regular Sunday.

Do I think there are 1,000 new parishioners at Mass this Sunday? No. However, I do hope that there are a few. Hopefully, there are those parishioners who before Sunday did not see Mass as something they did, but are back today. Hopefully, there are parishioners who would come to Mass “when they had time” who now know that God has to come first in their lives.

If you are one of those souls who found their way back to Jesus this weekend after having been away, or you are one who was a casual Catholic, but now wants to be all-in, praise be Jesus Christ. While our parish is big enough that many people will not recognize how your life has changed, God sees the change and is overjoyed.

What are some first steps?

If you're new to the faith or coming back after being away, here are some good first steps to grow a relationship with Jesus Christ.

1) Know He wants a relationship with you. Going to Mass is important; it's the source and summit of our Catholic life, but God wants us to speak to Him in prayer and love our neighbor every day.

2) Pray: Find a way and a space to pray every day. During the week this might include finding a spot in your home where you read the Bible or a devotional while you drink your morning cup of coffee. Perhaps you might pray the rosary, stop by a church to light a candle, or even attend a daily Mass once a week near your office or home.

3) Get a clean slate

If it's been a while since you've been to confession, don't be afraid. Come to confession and lighten your burdens, begin to heal the wounds caused by sin, and make sure you're in a proper state to receive Holy Communion.

4) Be with other Catholics

It's hard to follow Jesus. Even Jesus knew that. He called a group of Apostles and sent Disciples out two by two. If you don't know anyone in the parish think about joining a ministry or call our office to ask for recommendations.

5) Keep it up

Like a New Year's diet or a new gym membership, there are many who want to stay faithful to Mass, the commandments, and Christian life, but give up soon after starting out. There will come a Sunday when it's tough to come to Mass; come anyway. There will be a group of friends or family members who mock you because you “found religion all of a sudden”; pray for them and keep it up. There may be moral teachings you struggle with or don't understand; ask good questions, learn what you can, and stay anyway.

Remember to Pray and Don't Assume

If we see someone who is unsure about responses, if they're sitting in your spot, if they're dressed immodestly or inappropriately for Mass, etc. let's not condemn them. Who knows, that person could have been away for fifty years. Instead, let's greet them with a smile, offer a prayer of thanksgiving for them, and maybe introduce yourself to them.

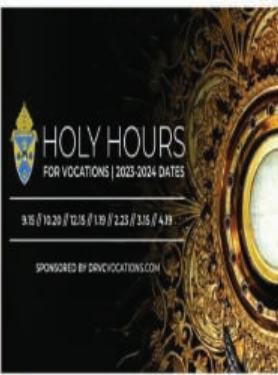
