## A Message From Our Pastor

**Dear Parishioners,**

As you know, this week we were blessed with some fine Spring weather, even if it meant dealing with pollen and allergies. Finally, able to open my office window, I was able to hear once again the laughter of children playing outside on our field during recess and the banter of our youngest students, as they went on their nature walks around our property.

Time to Get Outside

Thinking about it, I am so grateful my parents made me go outside when I was a kid. Often that meant I had time to play ball with my brother or neighborhood friends, ride bikes, get grass stains on my jeans, climb trees, throw rocks, use my imagination, jump in puddles, and all the typical things kids tend to do outside.

Did I always want to go outside? No. Often, if given the choice, I would have stayed inside all day watching TV and playing video games. Did I get a choice if I wanted to go outside? Again, no. On the days when I wanted to be a couch potato, I was told “You can’t stay couped up in the house all day. Go outside and we’ll tell you when dinner’s ready.” This also applied when I got older and wanted to read a book. I was told “God put that big sun in the sky. Go read outside, it’s better for your eyes.”

We all know spending time outside is healthy mentally and physically, but it does wonders for the soul. Sometimes I had nothing to do outside, and so I would think I would use my imagination, or to be technical, I would *develop my interior life*. It’s the questions about the natural world - *How big is the sky? How far away are the stars? How deep can I dig a hole?*- that prime a young mind to think about the supernatural world - *Who made the sky? Who orders the stars? Why am I here and who made me?* There’s little surprise that the more time a kid spends behind a screen, the tougher it is to pray.

To all the parents reading this, thank you for continuing the tradition of taking your kids outside. Thank you for going to the park, the beach, and hiking trails. Thank you for leaving the phone, the ipads, and all the screens in the car. Thank you for putting up with the complaints and initial fussiness because you know it’s worth it.

So many parents share with me their fond memories of playing outside as a kid but admit that the world is different today. It is different; it’s more important to go outside. When I was a kid, our family had one television, a computer in the family room with dial-up internet, and a Nintendo hooked up to that same TV; everything else available to distract us was toys and books. Today screens dominate; they’re in every room. We can be reminded of the words of the English poet Gerard Manly Hopkins:

*The world is charged with the grandeur of God.*

*It will flame out, like shining from shook foil;*

*It gathers to a greatness, like the ooze of oil*

*Crushed. Why do men then now not reck his rod?*

*Generations have trod, have trod, have trod;*

*And all is seared with trade; bleared, smeared with toil;*

*And wears man's smudge and shares man's smell: the soil*

*Is bare now, nor can foot feel, being shod.*

*And for all this, nature is never spent;*

*There lives the dearest freshness deep down things;*

*And though the last lights off the black West went*

*Oh, morning, at the brown brink eastward, springs —*

*Because the Holy Ghost over the bent*

*World broods with warm breast and with ah! bright wings.*

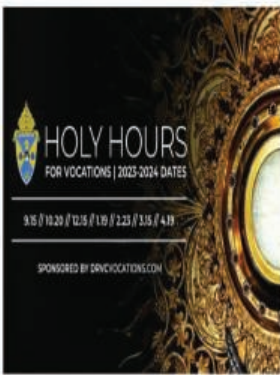

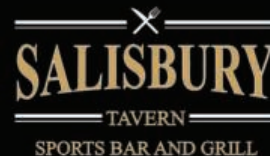
